Introductions

The Welsh Government sought views on plans to introduce domestic legislation, in the form of an amending Statutory Instrument (SI), to amend The Addition of Vitamins, Minerals and Other Substances (Wales) Regulations 2007 to include a provision for Article 8 on the prohibition or restriction of substances listed in Part A or B of Annex III of Regulation (EC) No 1925/2006. Stakeholders were asked their views on the appropriateness of extending the offences and penalties in The Addition of Vitamins, Minerals and Other Substances (Wales) Regulations 2007 to cover Part A and B of Annex III.

Stakeholder were asked to submit their comments via an online form or via email or post.

Summary of Responses

Only two responses were received to this consultation, both members of the public. Neither wished to have their details shared.

A summary of the responses provided to each question are below;

Question 1

Do you agree with the proposal to amend The Addition of Vitamins, Minerals and Other Substances (Wales) Regulations 2007 to include, under offences and penalties a provision for article 8 and Part A and B of Annex III of the European Regulation 2006/125/EC?

Both respondents agreed that the Regulations should be amended to include under offences and penalties a provision for article 8 and Part A and B of Annex III of the European Regulation 2006/125/EC

Question 2

Do you agree that the current enforcement regime, outlined above, should be extended to this provision?

Both respondents agreed that the current enforcement regime should be extended to this provision.
