Occasionally, we also ask stakeholders if they would like to provide feedback relating to the Programme in general or specific elements. The details we hold include name, email address, organisation, role, preferred language, area(s) of the Programme of specific interest and areas of expertise. Welsh Government will be the data controller for this information and we do not share it with other organisations.
