Thriving Places Wales update

We have recently updated our [Thriving Places Wales tool](#) with new data and scores for 2021. The tool measures the prevalence of conditions for well-being at a local authority geography, with a focus on individual and community well-being rather than financial well-being. It is reflective of conditions in a local authority area and is not a measure of the performance of any individual organisation, or groups of organisations.

The methodology of the tool remains unchanged, but we have added two new indicators for this year.
