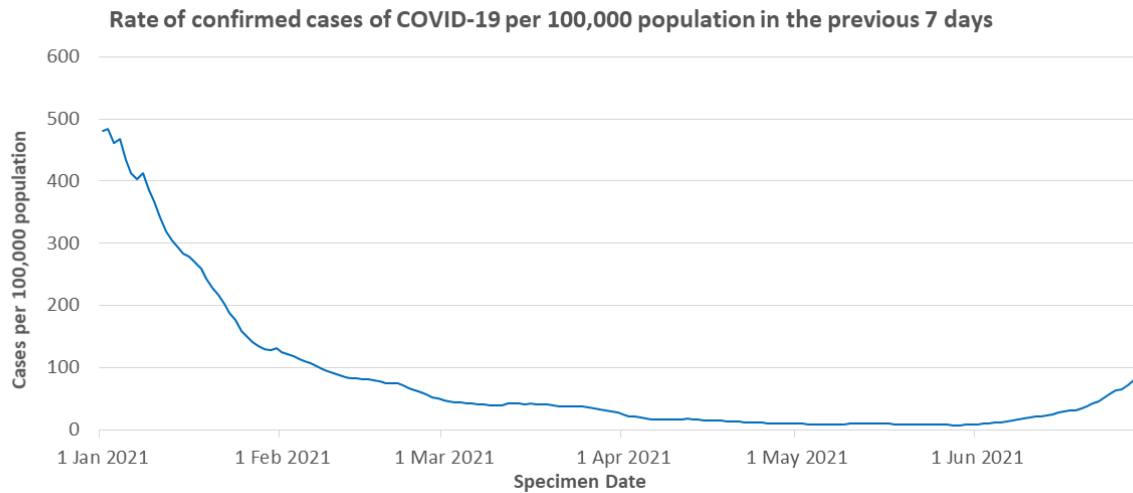

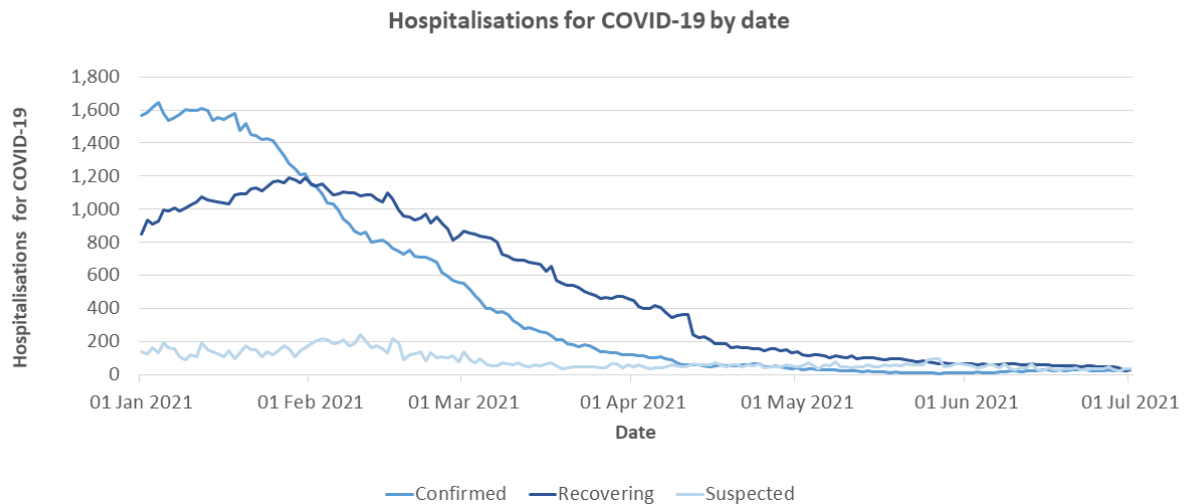
The 7-day incidence rate has increased in recent weeks.
