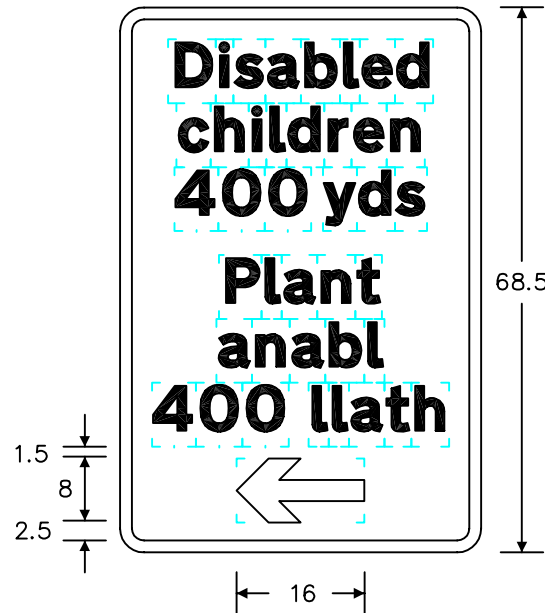
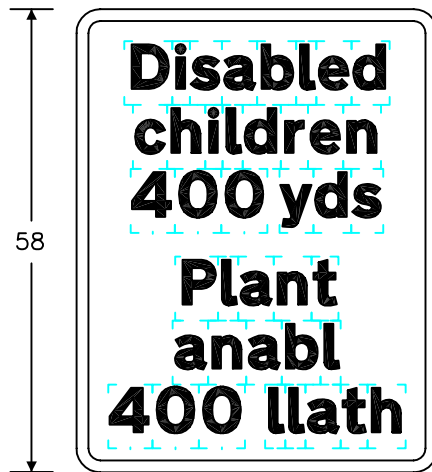
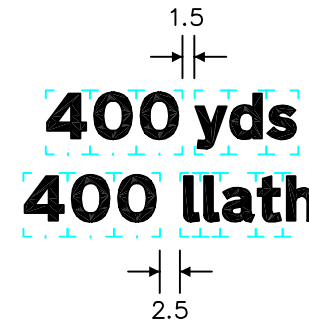


Notes:-

- The outlines of the tiles do not form part of the sign.
- The colours are as follows:-  
Background \_\_\_\_\_ White  
Legend, border & arrow \_\_\_\_\_ Black
- The illumination of the sign must accord with the requirements of the current 'Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions'.
- The 'x'-heights shown are given in millimetres, all other dimensions are given in stroke widths (i.e.  $1s/w = 1/4 \times \text{'x'-height}$ ).
- The sign is designed in accordance with the current design rules.
- The order of languages may be reversed if required.
- Blind children (Plant dall) or Deaf children (Plant byddar) may replace Disabled children.
