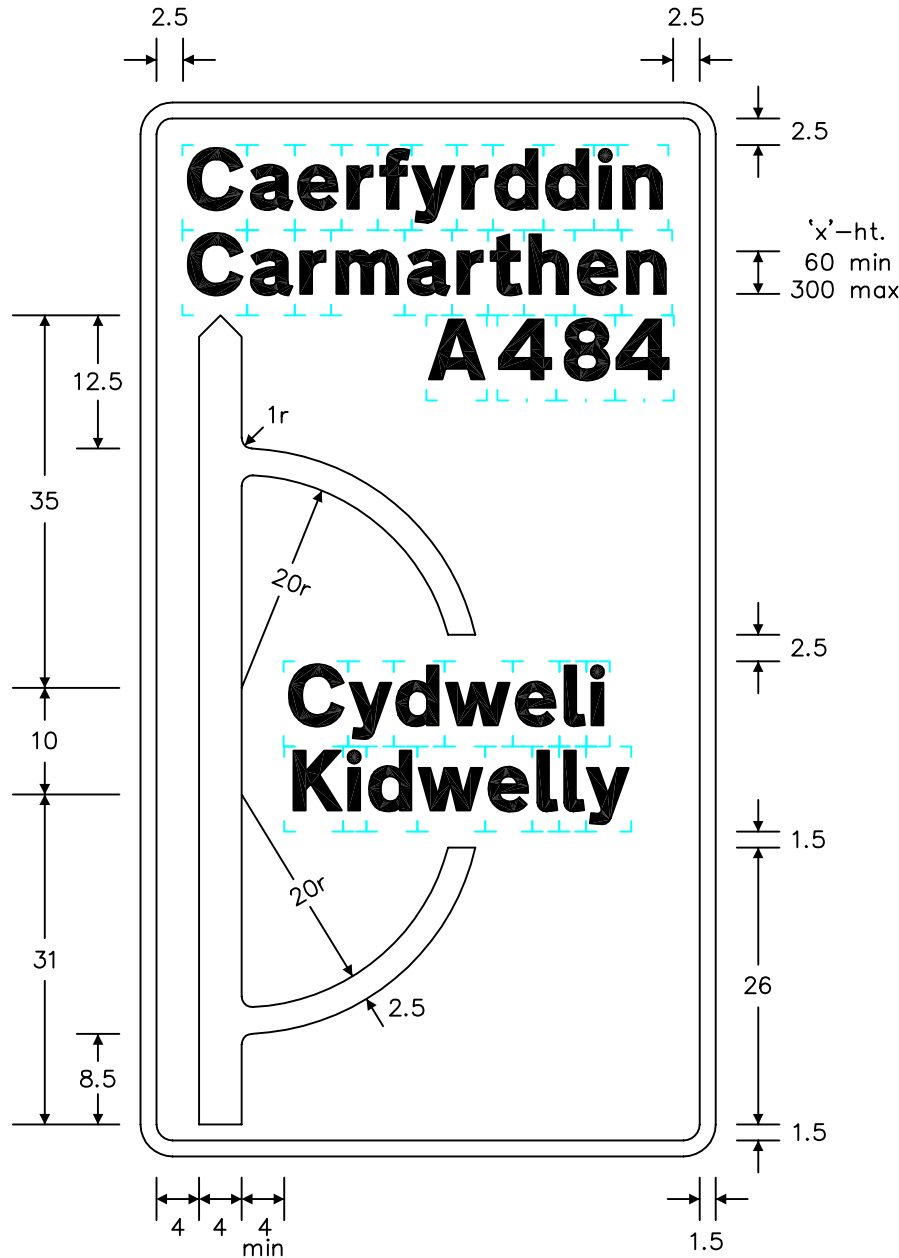
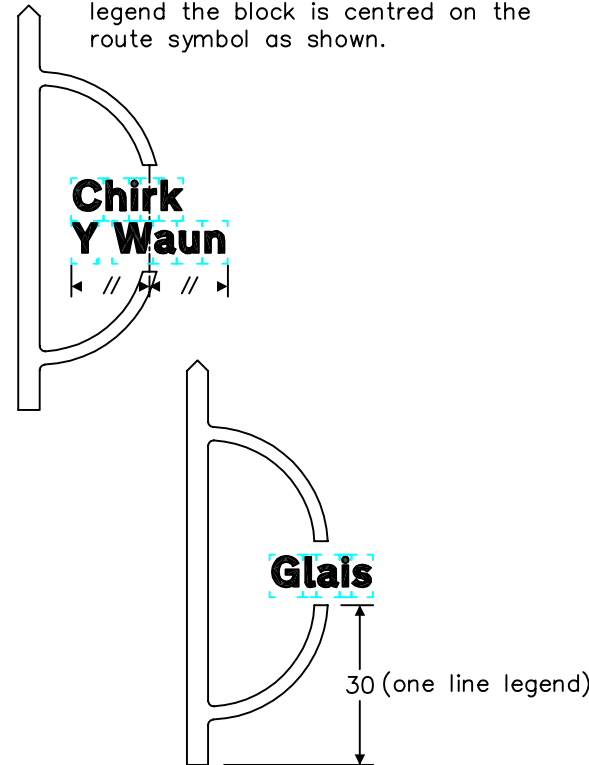


Notes: -

1. The legend is from the Transport Heavy alphabet at the 'x'-heights shown.
2. The outlines of the tiles do not form part of the sign.
3. The colours are as follows: -
Background _____ White
Border, legend & route symbol _____ Black
4. The illumination of the sign must accord with the requirements of the current 'Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions'.
5. The 'x'-heights shown are given in millimetres, all other dimensions are given in stroke widths (i.e. 1s/w = 1/4 'x'-height).
6. The sign is designed in accordance with the current design rules.
7. The order of languages may be reversed if required.



When the length of the destination block is less than 34sw for a single line legend or 31.7sw for a two line legend the block is centred on the route symbol as shown.
