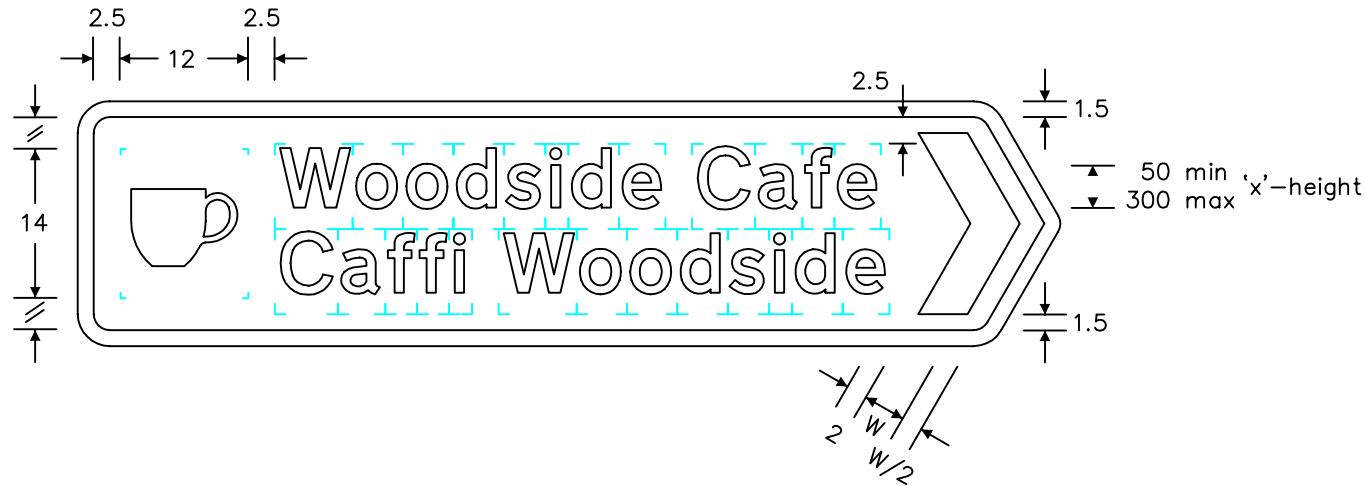


The width of the chevron is determined from the overall height of the sign and shall take the value as shown in the table below.

HEIGHT OF SIGN H sw	WIDTH OF CHEVRON W sw
<19	3
19 to <27	4
27 to <35	5
35 to <43	6
43 to <51	7
51 to <59	8

Notes:-

- The legend is from the Transport Medium alphabet at the 'x'-heights shown.
- The outlines of the tiles do not form part of the sign.
- The colours are as follows:-
Background ————— Brown
Border, legend, symbol and chevron ——— White
- Details of the 'Cup' symbol are given on Drwg. No. S 46.
- The illumination of the sign must accord with the requirements of the current 'Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions'.
- The 'x'-heights shown are given in millimetres, all other dimensions are given in stroke widths (i.e. $1s/w = 1/4 \times \text{'x'-height}$).
- The sign is designed in accordance with the current design rules.
- The order of languages may be reversed if required.
