ATISN 10032 – 2015 GCSE Results

Thank you for your request for information which I received on 9 December 2015. In your request, you asked for:

For the 2015 GCSE results in Wales, a data set summary for the core subjects English (all), Maths, Science, and Welsh first language (all) including:

- The percentage of pupils who pass at A*-C.
- English medium and Welsh medium secondary (and middle) schools shown separately.
- Schools grouped according to EFSM (three year average) at 5% intervals starting from 0-10% EFSM. The last group will be 15% whatever the highest percentage is currently for a WM school.
- Level 2 inclusive of English/Welsh + Maths.
- Level 2 inclusive of English + Maths (omitting Welsh in order to discover the value of Welsh in the L2+ calculation).

The Welsh Government holds the information that you have requested and this data has been provided in the attached annex.
