Request for Information – ATISN reference 11244 (Internal Review)

Thank you for your request which was received by the Welsh Government on 25 May 2017. Following our disclosure letter dated 23 May 2017, you requested an internal review into our decision to withhold procurement card information under section 22 of the Freedom of the Freedom of Information Act (and our omission of the necessary public tested argument in our first response to you).

I can confirm the arguments necessary to be put forward in our original disclosure under the exemption referred to above were incorrectly omitted. Whilst this information has now been provided to you, I uphold this part of your complaint.

Following my review; notwithstanding the omission of arguments as outlined above, I am satisfied Welsh Government cited the correct exemption for non disclosure. I do not believe the public interest argument for the release of information (then or now) outweighs that for withholding given the stated intention in our original disclosure to publish in due course.

Welsh Government information on Procurement cards will be published imminently (within a week) and as such, I have not upheld this part of your complaint.
