### Request for Information – ATISN 11363

Thank you for your email on 23 June regarding your request for information. In your request you asked for:

1. What steps did the Welsh Government take to inform the public and bus passengers of the existence of the WG30602 consultation document?
  - a) **A statement was made by the Welsh Government in the National Assembly and published on the Welsh Government website on 28 February 2017.**
  - b) **The consultation was published on the Welsh Government website on 8 March 2017.**
  - c) **The Cabinet Secretary for Economy and Infrastructure issued a letter to Assembly Members on 8 March 2017.**
  - d) **The consultation is also promulgated amongst a variety of identified interest groups including local authorities, public transport user groups, delivery bodies and agents, unions, disability groups, and other advisory bodies.**
2. How many responses in total were received by the Welsh Government to the WG30602 consultation document?

3. How many responses to the WG30602 consultation document were from the public/bus passengers?  
**32**
4. How many responses to the WG30602 consultation document were from the public/bus passengers in Ceredigion?

5. When will the “Summary of Responses” document (which the Welsh Government proposed to produce) be published?  
**The exact date is to be confirmed but it is expected by the end of December 2017.**
