Request for Information – ATISN reference 11784- Investigation Documentation

Thank you for your request which was received by the Welsh Government on 30 November 2017. You asked for the following information:

Welsh Government procedure/s to appoint to investigator James Hamilton into WG bullying claims. I would like to read all data pertaining to the choice of investigators and subsequent decision to appoint the investigator James Hamilton tasked with investigating claims of bullying and subsequent internal investigatory procedures used and applied in the Welsh Government 2014 - 2017.

As the Welsh Government had no arrangements in place for the First Minister to refer potential breaches of the Ministerial Code to an Independent Adviser, the Welsh Government approached the Scottish Government for details of their panel of Advisers. Two names were provided and James Hamilton was the first to confirm his availability. The terms of reference for the inquiry have been published.
