Request for Information – ATISN 12075

I write to you on 20 February regarding your request for information. You asked for:

- the annual spend in the local press of Road Traffic Regulation Orders (when there are going to be road closures etc.) for both the consultation and the Order
- a history of annual spends or latest years figures

I can confirm that we hold information relating to your request. Welsh Ministers are responsible for Traffic Regulation Orders (TROs) relating to Trunk Roads and Motorways. These fall within two main categories; Permanent Orders and Temporary Traffic Regulation Orders.

Spend in recent years is as follows:

Financial Year	TRO Spend (ex.VAT)
2017/18 (up to date of this letter)	£287,290.00
2016/17	£476,902.06
2015/16	£650,400.98
