Please find attached my final report of my September 2018 Twll Du bat survey for which I sent you an interim report two days ago.

The implication of the survey results is that access will need to be maintained for flight access by lesser horseshoe bats and that any works that may potentially obstruct or restrict bat flight access into the cave at this entrance will require licensing from Natural Resources Wales (NRW).
