Thank you for your request which I received on 18 December 2018. You asked for:

Copies of correspondence (email, letters or otherwise) sent or received by Welsh Government Cabinet Secretaries, Ministers, Special Advisors and Welsh Government officials and press officers regarding Hendy Wind Farm between 1st October and 18th December 2018.

I have enclosed with this letter, some of the information in respect of your request, which I believe is what you requested as identified on the disclosure list. Information is being withheld under Regulation 12(4)(e) of the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 as they are considered internal communications. We are also withholding information under Regulation 13, as it constitutes the personal data of third parties.

The information caught by your request constitutes environmental information so has been considered for disclosure under the Environmental Information Regulations (EIRs). I have decided some of the information described in the enclosed list is exempt from disclosure under regulations 12(4)(e) and 13 of the EIRs. The reasons for applying these exemptions are set out in full at Annex 1 to this letter.

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response. Requests for an internal review should be addressed to the Welsh Government's Freedom of Information Officer at:

We welcome receiving correspondence in Welsh. Any correspondence received in Welsh will be answered in Welsh and corresponding in Welsh will not lead to a delay in responding.

Regulation 12(4)(e) – Disclosure of internal communications

Regulation 12(4)(e) of the EIRs sets out an exception from the right to know for information contained within documents considered to be internal communications. The information in question was internal advice to and from the Cabinet Secretary for Energy, Planning and Rural Affairs and officials. This is clearly “internal communications”, and, as such, falls within the scope of the exception.

This exception is subject to the public interest test, and I must determine whether the public interest favours releasing or withholding this document. This Annex sets out our subsequent consideration of the Public Interest Test.

Public interest arguments in favour of disclosure

We recognise there is a general public interest in openness of information and transparency in the working of government.

We recognise the release of the advice provided to the Cabinet Secretary prior to her reaching her final decision is conducive to the effective conduct of public affairs in providing openness of information and transparency in the planning process. We also recognise the release of advice prepared by other departments following the issuing of the decision and subsequent actions by third parties could be conducive to providing transparency.

Public interest arguments in favour of withholding

Where an official prepares advice for the Welsh Ministers into a called-in application or a planning appeal, the advice sets out the evidence presented at the hearing/inquiry, their conclusions on the main issues and makes a recommendation to the Welsh Ministers. The Welsh Ministers consider those recommendations, which they may choose to accept or reject. Until the Welsh Ministers make a decision the advice forms part of internal advice.

Once the decision has been taken, the main parties to the application/appeal receive a copy of the decision letter and other parties may request a copy. Thereafter a challenge to a decision can be made within 6 weeks by way of an appeal to the High Court under Section 288 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990. The decision by the Cabinet Secretary in this case is subject to High Court proceedings, which have not yet been considered by the Courts. Should that High Court challenge prove successful and the decision is quashed, the decision no longer exists. The advice will, therefore, continue to form part of internal advice.

The advice provided to the Cabinet Secretary is conducive to the public interest which is to have an efficient and transparent planning system, which is fair to all. If the conclusions and recommendations of the officials contained within this advice are released before a decision is final, there is a risk it will undermine the efficiency, transparency and impartiality of the planning process.

Balance of public interest test

On balance I have found that the public interest lies in withholding the information until the decision on the case before the High Court is concluded and the challenge process is exhausted. The advice provided to the Cabinet Secretary prior to her issuing her decision

will also be made available once this process has concluded. The information is therefore being withheld.

Internal correspondence between departments or between officials to provide briefings on issues raised is clearly 'internal communications, the publication of such advice would undermine the transparency and impartiality of the advice given which, in our view, would not be in the wider public benefit and is therefore being withheld.

Regulation 13– Personal data

Regulation 13 of the EIRs sets out an exemption from the right to know if the information requested is personal information protected by the Data Protection Act 1998 (DPA). Personal data is defined in Section 1(1) of the DPA as:

“personal data” means data which relates to a living individual who can be identified from those data; or from those data and other information which is in the possession of, or is likely to come into the possession of, the data controller.

We have concluded that, in this instance, the information requested contains third party personal data. Under Regulation 13(1) of the EIRs, personal data is exempt from release if disclosure would breach one of the data protection principles. We consider the principle being most relevant in this instance as being the first.

The first data protection principle states:

*Personal data shall be processed fairly and lawfully and, in particular, shall not be processed unless—
(a) at least one of the conditions in Schedule 2 is met, and (b) in the case of sensitive personal data, at least one of the conditions in Schedule 3 is also met.*

We consider that the identity of a member of the public clearly falls within the description of personal data as defined by the DPA and that its disclosure would breach the first data protection principle. The first data protection principle has two components:

- 1 Personal data shall be processed fairly and lawfully and
2. Personal data shall not be processed unless at least one of the conditions in DPA schedule 2 is met

Guidance from the Information Commissioner’s Office (Personal information (section 40 and regulation 13) v 1.3) states (at p11):

The starting point is to consider whether it would be fair to the data subject to disclose their personal data. The key considerations in assessing this are set out in the section on Fairness below.

If disclosure would not be fair, then the information is exempt from disclosure.

This approach was endorsed by the Court of Appeal in the case of Deborah Clark v the Information Commissioner and East Hertfordshire District Council where it was held:

“The first data protection principle entails a consideration of whether it would be fair to disclose the personal data in all the circumstances. The Commissioner determined that it would not be fair to disclose the requested information and thus the first data protection

principle would be breached. There was no need in the present case therefore to consider whether any other Schedule 2 condition or conditions could be met because even if such conditions could be established, it would still not be possible to disclose the personal data without breaching the DPA” (paragraph 63).

In this instance, we believe the individual would have no expectation that this information would be made public. Thus, we believe release of this information would be unfair and so breach the first data protection principle. For that reason, the information is being withheld under Regulation 13(1) of the EIRs. This is an absolute exemption and not subject to the public interest tests.
