I am one of several with grazing rights on Llandegley Common and SOMEWHAT SURPRISED that Hendy have not contacted any of us to explain how we are to access the common during construction period nor confirmed if we are to have compensatory grazing land offered, to make up for that lost. The exact placement of tracks across the common also seems not yet settled. Are you able to give us this information?

After a harsh winter, followed by drought in summer hay and straw is in short supply and grazing land is very important to the farmers who graze their animals on the common.
