We have been in contact previously concerning noise from turbines at Garreg Lwyd -1 in particular. A pounding noise, not to do with loudness, which pervades you and cannot be ignored. In short RES admit there is a problem possibly as the turbines are so big and this one in particular dominates our whole view. We believe not enough testing was done beforehand. They have been testing and stopping from certain wind directions and speeds and (fingers crossed) hope to find a solution after nearly 2 years. We would urge you to consider carefully to avoid a similar thing happening at the Hendy site near Rhos common or indeed any other sites in Wales where they are positioned to possibly devastate people's lives. We have lived and worked from this lovely old farmhouse, and brought up a family, for 40 years and love Wales but the peace and beauty are at risk of being ruined.
