Thank you for your email on 19 November, regarding my decision to allow the planning appeal for Hendy Wind Farm, near Llandrindod Wells.

It is important to ensure, in the interests of natural justice, decisions are based on an open and fair consideration of all relevant planning matters. Accordingly, as Cabinet Secretary with responsibility for Planning, I must not take any actions which might be seen as prejudicial to the planning decision-making process. Therefore, it is not appropriate for me to undertake site visits when making determinations on planning appeals. However, the Inspector carried out an accompanied site visit on 23 March 2018 which provided an opportunity for the parties to point out to the Inspector any physical features they considered important and material to the determination of the appeal. The Inspector also undertook unaccompanied visits to public vantage points within the surrounding area. The findings of the Inspector are set out in his report, which I considered in the determination of the appeal.

As the Minister responsible for planning I am entitled to disagree with the recommendation of the Inspector. The Welsh Ministers are unable to provide any further comment on the decision as, under planning law, the Welsh Ministers' decision on the appeal is final and it is not possible for me, or anyone else within the Welsh Government or the Planning Inspectorate, to comment on the merits of the decision, the reasoning behind it, or to reconsider it.
