Thank you for your request which I received on 29/01/19. You asked:

Can the Welsh Government name any other country in the world, apart from possibly Israel, where children are not educated through their majority language, where they must learn through a minority language...

Following a search of our paper and electronic records, I have established that the information you require is not held by the Welsh Government.
