ATISN 12924: School Census Software

Thank you for your request which I received on 29 January 2019. You asked for the following information:

Details surrounding the software used by schools to return the January 2017 and January 2018 school census. Additionally, through the use of the Pupil Level Annual School Census you requested that we provide details surrounding software used for September 2016, September 2017 and September 2018. Specifically, you asked for:

- *Local authority number*
- *Local authority name*
- *URN number*
- *School name*
- *Establishment type*
- *Establishment phase*
- *MIS software used*
- *Numbers of pupils on roll*

Welsh Government holds some of the information you have requested and is attached in annex A.

Please note, the Welsh Government does not hold information on the name of the supplier of the MIS software. Although we do hold the codes and have provided these, we no longer maintain a list of the names of the suppliers and which codes refer to them. MIS suppliers are free to use whatever code they choose.
