Thank you for your request which I received on 3/02/2019. You asked for:

*The number of schools categorised as Green, Yellow, Amber and Red in each of the years since colour coded categorisation has been in effect in Wales and further to this a breakdown of the numbers of schools in each of these colour coded bands that were a) working in a deficit budget, b) paying back LA or WG loans to correct a deficit budget, and/or c) without a permanent substantive head teacher?*
