Thank you for your request, which I received on 22 March. In your request you asked for:

“Under the specific terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, and no other legislation or law, please provide documentation which gives meaning and substance to your employed phrase “exceptional circumstances” as a reason to overrule the Planning Inspector in respect of Hendy Windfarm.”

The reference to “exceptional circumstance” is contained within the Cabinet Secretary’s decision letter, a copy of which is attached for your information. The decision letter should be read as a whole, to put the reference in context.
