Request for Information – ATISN reference 13174

Thank you for your request which I received on 18 March 2019. Please accept my apologies for the delay in responding. You requested the following:

if there was perhaps a record of the Welsh Government ever at any time having claimed, reserved and defended its right to fraudulently and maliciously tamper with the Performance Appraisals of its Civil Servants, to silence them in perpetuity, to bully, threaten and intimidate them, to sack them without right of reply, and to use the mental health of them and their wives and children as legitimate management tool?

We have no record and our practice is that we would never deliberately tamper with performance appraisal records.
