  - Current absence set against FSM level of the school.
  - Persistent absentees set against FSM level of the school
- Any contextual value added for KS4 results for 2018 results
- % of children with school action (SEN)
- % of children with school action plus (SEN)
- % of children who are statemented (SEN)
- % of children with English as an additional language
- % of children that recorded their ethnic background as anything other than "White-British"
