Coming into force 11 April 2014

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the Swansea to Manchester Trunk Road (A483) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 124 and paragraph 27 of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) (hereinafter referred to as “the 1984 Act”), and after consultation with the Chief Officer of the Dyfed-Powys Police, make this Order.

Title and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 11 April and its title is The A483 Trunk Road (Derwydd, Llandybie, Dyfed) (De-Restriction) Order 1995 Revocation Order 2014.

Revocation

2. The A483 Trunk Road (Derwydd, Llandybie, Dyfed) (De-Restriction) Order 1995(2) is hereby revoked.

The Welsh Ministers have made an Order under section 124 of and paragraph 27 of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to revoke The A483 Trunk Road (Derwydd, Llandybie, Dyfed) (De-Restriction) Order 1995, which has been superseded by The A483 Trunk Road (Derwydd, Llandybie, Carmarthenshire) (40 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2002. The Order comes into force on the 11 April 2014.
