The Welsh Ministers (in this Order called “the acquiring authority”) make the following Order-

1. Subject to the provisions of this Order, the acquiring authority is, under sections 239, 240, 246, 254 and 260 of the Highways Act 1980(1) as extended and supplemented by section 250 of that Act and under section 2 of, and paragraph 1(1)(b), (3) and (4) of Part 1 of Schedule 2 to the Acquisition of Land Act 1981(2), and all other enabling powers (3), hereby authorised to purchase compulsorily the land and the new rights over land described in paragraph 2 for the purpose of:

- (a) the construction of the new trunk road from Brynmawr to Tredegar, all in the communities of Sirhowy, Rassau, Beaufort and Brynmawr North in the County Borough of Blaenau Gwent, in pursuance of the Trunk Road Order;
- (b) the construction and improvement of highways and the provision of new means of access to premises in the said communities in the said County Borough in pursuance of the Side Roads Order;
- (c) the improvement of the Trunk Road in the said communities in the said County Borough;
- (d) the execution of works on watercourses in connection with the construction of the new trunk road and the construction and improvement of other highways and the execution of other works mentioned above;

(e) use by the Welsh Ministers in connection with such construction and improvement of highways and the execution of other works mentioned above; and

(f) the mitigation of adverse effects of highways or proposed highways on their surroundings.

Copies of the Trunk Road Order and the Side Roads Order both with their accompanying plans are deposited along with the map referred to in paragraph 6.

2. The land authorised to be purchased compulsorily under this Order is the land described in the accompanying Schedule 1 and delineated and shown coloured pink edged red on the map and the new rights to be purchased compulsorily over land under this Order are described in the Schedule 1 and the land is shown coloured blue edged red on the said map.

3. Parts II and III of Schedule 2 to the Acquisition of Land Act 1981 are hereby incorporated with this Order subject to the modifications that references in the said Parts of the said Schedule to the undertaking shall be construed as references to the land authorised to be purchased and any buildings or works constructed or to be constructed thereon.

4. For the purpose of the provisions of Schedule 2 to the Acquisition of Land Act 1981, as incorporated in this Order, the prescribed distance in relation to any seam of minerals lying under land adjoining the works to be constructed upon the land described in the Schedule to this Order shall be such a lateral distance from the said works on every side thereof as is equal at every point along the said works to one half of the depth of the seam below the natural surface of the ground at that point or 37 metres whichever is the greater.

5. (1) (a) In this paragraph, “the order land” means the land numbered 4\3j, 4\3l, 4\3m, 4\3z, 4\3ae, 4\8a, 4\8b, 4\9, 4\9i, 5\1a, 5\1b, 5\1c, 5\1d, 5\2c, 5\2d, 5\2f, 5\2k, 5\2l, 5\2m, 5\2p, 5\2r, 5\2s, 5\2t, 5\2v, 5\2w, 5\2x, 5\2y, 5\2af, 5\4a, 5\4b, 5\4c, 5\4d, 5\4e, 5\4j, 5\4l, 6\1a, 6\1b, 6\2, 6\2b, 6\2c, 6\2e, 6\3a, 6\3i, 6\4a in Schedule 1 and “the exchange land” means the land described in Schedule 2.

(b) For a plot of the exchange land, its corresponding plot of the order land for the purposes of this paragraph is indicated in the last column of Table 2 in Schedule 2.

(2) In relation to each plot of the order land and the corresponding plot of the exchange land, as from the latest of the dates mentioned in sub-paragraph (3) of this paragraph, the corresponding plot of the exchange land will vest in the persons in whom that plot of the order land was vested immediately before it was vested in the acquiring authority, subject to the like rights, trusts and incidents as attached to that plot of the order land; and that plot of the order land will thereupon be discharged from all rights, trusts and incidents to which it was previously subject.

(3) The dates referred to in sub-paragraph (2) of this paragraph are the date on which—

- (i) this order becomes operative;
- (ii) the plot of the order land is vested in the acquiring authority;
- (iii) the corresponding plot of the exchange land is vested in the acquiring authority.

“the new trunk road” - (“y gefnffordd newydd”) means the trunk road to be constructed in pursuance of the Trunk Road Order ;

“the Trunk Road Order” - (“y Gorchymyn Cefnffordd”) means the Neath To Abergavenny Trunk Road (A465) (Abergavenny To Hirwaun Dualling And Slip Roads) And East Of Abercynon To East Of Dowlais Trunk Road (A4060) And Cardiff To Glan Conwy Trunk Road (A470) (Connecting Roads) Order 1999, as amended by the Neath To Abergavenny Trunk Road (A465) (Abergavenny To Hirwaun Dualling And Slip Roads) And East Of Abercynon To East Of Dowlais Trunk Road (A4060) And Cardiff To Glan Conwy Trunk Road (A470) (Connecting Roads) Order 1999 (Brynmawr To Tredegar) (Amendment) Order 201- ; and

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Welsh Ministers have prepared in draft 'The Welsh Ministers (The Neath To Abergavenny Trunk Road (A465) (Abergavenny To Hirwaun Dualling And Slip Roads) And East Of Abercynon To East Of Dowlais Trunk Road (A4060) And Cardiff To Glan Conwy Trunk Road (A470) (Connecting Roads) (Brynmawr To Tredegar)) Compulsory Purchase Order 201-', under sections 239, 240, 246, 250, 254 and 260 of the Highways Act 1980 and under section 2 of, and paragraph 1(1)(b), (3) and (4) of Part 1 of Schedule 2 to the Acquisition of Land Act 1981. The Welsh Ministers are about to make this Order and if made the Order will authorise the Welsh Ministers to purchase compulsorily the land and new rights described below for the purpose of: -

- (a) the construction of the new trunk road from Brynmawr to Tredegar, all in the communities of Sirhowy, Rassau, Beaufort and Brynmawr North in the County Borough of Blaenau Gwent, in pursuance of the Neath To Abergavenny Trunk Road (A465) (Abergavenny To Hirwaun Dualling And Slip Roads) And East Of Abercynon To East Of Dowlais Trunk Road (A4060) And Cardiff To Glan Conwy Trunk Road (A470) (Connecting Roads) Order 1999, as amended by the Neath To Abergavenny Trunk Road (A465) (Abergavenny To Hirwaun Dualling And Slip Roads) And East Of Abercynon To East Of Dowlais Trunk Road (A4060) And Cardiff To Glan Conwy Trunk Road (A470) (Connecting Roads) Order 1999, (Brynmawr To Tredegar) (Amendment) Order 201-;
- (b) the construction and improvement of highways and the provision of new means of access to premises in the said Communities in the said County Borough in pursuance of

- (c) the improvement of the Trunk Road in the said Communities in the said County Borough;
- (d) the execution of works on watercourses in connection with the construction of the new trunk road and the construction and improvement of other highways and the execution of other works mentioned above;
- (e) use by the Welsh Ministers in connection with such improvement of highways and the execution of other works mentioned above; and
- (f) the mitigation of any adverse effects which the existence or use of certain of the highways proposed to be constructed or improved will have on the surroundings thereof.

#### DESCRIPTION OF THE LAND AND THE NEW RIGHTS

##### NOTE

- a. the land comprised in each item below is identified on the map referred to in the draft Order by means of the number or numbers against that item below.

#### IN THE COMMUNITY OF SIRHOWY IN THE COUNTY BOROUGH OF BLAENAU GWENT

Part of the A465 Trunk Road at Nant-Y-Bwch, roundabout, subway and other associated highway features and parts of the classified and unclassified roads known as Llwyn Helyg including Glen View, the A4048, Station Road, Highfield Close, Pant-Y-Dwr and its rear access, [electricity sub-station], Highfield Close, rough grassland, part of public footpaths 339/87/1 and 339/93/1 and unauthorised footpaths, along the line of and on the north and south of the existing A465 Trunk Road; the property known as 2 Pant-Y-Dwr, full width of the unclassified road fronting it; full width of bed of Sirhowy River, weirs and river bank, and disused underground mineral workings. (Plots 1/1, 1/1a, 1/1b, 1/1c, 1/1d and 1/1e).

Grassland, part of public footpath 339/87/1, part of full width and half width of public highway known as Station Road, verge and footway, track, river bank, and disused underground mineral workings, south of

the existing A465 Trunk Road, north of St Luke's Road and west of the Sirhowy River; part of National Cycle Route 46 south of Dukestown municipal cemetery and north of the A465; part of Dukestown municipal cemetery, north of the existing A465 Trunk Road and south of the property known as Coed Hirgan Farm; the right to enter, including vehicular access, upon grassland, river bed and bank, south of and under the existing A465 Trunk Road and west of the Sirhowy River, for all purposes connected with construction and maintenance of a headwall, construction and maintenance of the Sirhowy River Bridge, drainage works; the right to enter, including vehicular access, upon grassland, part of Dukestown municipal cemetery, north of the existing A465 Trunk Road for all purposes connected with construction and maintenance of a retaining wall and rock anchors. (Plots 1/2, 1/2a, 1/2b, 1/2c, 1/2d, 1/2e, 1/2f, 1/2g, 1/2h, 1/2i, 1/2j, 1/2k, 1/2l, 1/2m, 1/2n, 1/2p and 1/2q).

Grassland, land drainage, unnamed water course, part of footpath 339/93/1 and disused underground mineral workings, north of the existing A465 Trunk Road and west of the Sirhowy River; grassland north of 5 and 6 Pant-Y-Dwr; sloping grassland and disused underground mineral workings, north of the existing A465 Trunk Road and south of the National Cycle Route 46; sloping rock and disused underground mineral workings east of the River Sirhowy and north of the existing A465 Trunk Road. (Plots 1/3, 1/3a, 1/3b, 1/3c, 1/3d, 1/3e, 1/3f, 1/3g, 1/3h, 1/3i, 1/3j and 1/3k).

Houses and gardens of the properties known as 1 and 3 Pant-Y-Dwr and full widths of unclassified road, verge and footway to the front of the properties, and disused underground mineral workings; full widths of public highway, verge and footway to the front of the properties known as 7 and 8 Pant-Y-Dwr; full width of public highway, verge, footway and part of the front garden and disused underground mineral workings of the property known as 6 Pant-Y-Dwr. (Plots 1/4, 1/4a, 1/4b, 1/4c, 1/4d, 1/4e and 1/4f).

House and garden of the property known as 4 Pant-Y-Dwr and full width of unclassified road, verge and footway to the front of the property, and disused underground mineral workings. (Plot 1/5).

Full width of unclassified road, verge, footway and part of the front garden and disused underground mineral workings of the property known as 5 Pant-Y-Dwr. (Plots 1/6, 1/6a and 1/6b).

Half width of the public highway, verge and footway to the front of the property known as 16 Station Road,



Nant-Y-Bwch south of the existing A465 Trunk Road. (Plot 1/7).

Grassland, riverbank and disused underground mineral workings, north of, and beneath, the existing A465 Trunk Road; grassland north of the existing A465 Trunk Road and west of River Sirhowy; the right to enter, including vehicular access, upon river bed and banks and disused underground mineral workings, of the River Sirhowy for all purposes connected with construction and maintenance of the bridge to carry the new widened existing A465 Trunk Road over the river and the treatment of disused underground mineral works including drilling and grouting. (Plots 1/8, 1/8a, 1/8b and 1/8c)

Half width of the public highway, verge and footway to the front of the property known as 15 Station Road, south of the existing A465 Trunk Road. (Plot 1/9).

Part of National Cycle Route 46, streams, land drainage, grassland and disused underground mineral workings, south of Dukestown municipal cemetery and north of the existing A465 Trunk Road. (Plots 1/10, 1/10a, 1/10b and 1/10c).

Steep sloping grassland and disused underground mineral workings, south of the existing A465 Trunk Road and east of the River Sirhowy; the right to enter, including vehicular access, upon river bed and banks and half width of the River Sirhowy south of the existing A465 Trunk Road, for all purposes connected with the construction and maintenance of a bridge to carry the new widened existing A465 Trunk Road over the river and the treatment of disused underground mineral works including drilling and grouting and all associated works. (Plots 1/11 and 1/11a).

Highway verge, garage forecourt of Ambay Service Station and half width of unnamed access road, south of Nant-Y-Bwch roundabout. (Plot 1/12).

Grassland, riverbank and disused underground mineral workings, north of the existing A465 Trunk Road and east and west of the Sirhowy River; the right to enter, including vehicular access, upon river bed and banks of the River Sirhowy, for all purposes connected with construction and maintenance of the bridge to carry the new widened existing A465 Trunk Road over the river and the treatment of disused underground mineral works including drilling and grouting. (Plots 1/13, 1/13a, 1/13b and 1/13c).

Part of the existing A465 Trunk Road, verge and disused underground mineral workings, north of Unit 1A Crown Business Park and south of Tyntyla and Hirgan Farm; grassland, south of the property known

as Coed Hirgan Farm, south-west of property known as Upper Hirgan Fach Farm and adjacent to Dukestown Cemetery; grassland, south of the property known as Coed Hirgan Farm and adjacent to the access road leading to Dukestown Cemetery; grassland, south-east of property known as Coed Hirgan Farm and south of the property known as Upper Hirgan Fach Farm; highway verge and shrubland, south of the existing A465 Trunk Road at Dukestown, north of and adjacent to the rear of Unit 1a Crown Business Park. (Plots 2/1, 2/1a, 2/1b, 2/1c, 2/1d, 2/1e, 2/1f, 2/1g, 2/1h, 2/1s and 2/1y).

Access road leading to Dukestown Cemetery, grassland and disused underground mineral workings, north of the existing A465 Trunk Road and south of the property known as Coed Hirgan Farm; part of the unclassified highway known as Crown Avenue and disused underground mineral workings, including part of bridge known as Crown Avenue bridge south of existing A465 Trunk Road; grassland and land drainage between footpath 339/105/2 and the southern boundary of the existing A465 Trunk Road adjacent to the Crown Business Park, Dukestown; the right to enter, including vehicular access, upon the access road leading to Dukestown Cemetery, north of the existing A465 Trunk Road and south of the property known as Coed Hirgan Farm, for all purposes connected with construction and maintenance of a retaining wall and insertion and maintenance of rock anchors; the right to enter, including vehicular access, upon grassland between footpath 339/105/2 and the southern boundary of the existing A465 Trunk Road adjacent to the Crown Business Park, Dukestown, for all purposes connected with construction and maintenance of drainage works. (Plots 2/2, 2/2a, 2/2b, 2/2c, 2/2d, 2/2w, 2/2y and 2/2z).

Access track leading to Upper Hirgan Fach Farm and Coed Hirgan Farm, north of Crown Avenue and north of the existing A465 Trunk Road; the right to enter, including vehicular access, upon verge adjacent to Upper Hirgan Fach Farm, Crown Avenue, north of existing A465 Trunk Road for all purposes connected with the construction and maintenance of a retaining wall and insertion and maintenance of rock anchors. (Plots 2/3, 2/3a, 2/3b, 2/3d and 2/3e).

Part of the garden and access road to the property known as Upper Hirgan Fach Farm, Crown Avenue, north of the existing A465 Trunk Road; the right to enter, including vehicular access, upon part of the garden of the Upper Hirgan Fach Farm to provide access for all purposes connected with construction and maintenance of a retaining wall and insertion and maintenance of rock anchors. (Plots 2/4, 2/4a, 2/4b, 2/4c and 2/4d).

Grazing land and part of footpath 339/96/1, south of existing A465 Trunk Road and west of Crown Avenue; the right to enter, including vehicular access, upon grazing land and part of footpath 339/96/1, south of existing A465 Trunk Road and west of Crown Avenue for all purposes connected with construction and maintenance of a new road bridge. (Plots 2/5, 2/5a and 2/5b).

Grazing land and disused underground mineral workings, including unnamed water course and half width of water course, at, east and south-east of the property known as Tyntyla, Hiranfach Farm and north of the existing A465 Trunk Road; the right to enter, including vehicular access, upon grazing land at and east of the property known as Tyntyla, Hiranfach Farm and north of the existing A465 Trunk Road for all purposes connected with the construction and maintenance of a retaining wall and insertion and maintenance of rock anchors. (Plots 2/6, 2/6a, 2/6b, 2/6c, 2/6d and 2/6e).

Shrubland to the rear of Unit 1a Crown Business Park south of the existing A465 Trunk Road. (Plots 2/7, 2/7a, 2/7b, 2/7c, 2/7d and 2/7e).

Grazing land and half width of water course at Hiran Farm at its boundary with Tyntyla, Hiranfach Farm and unnamed water course, rough grassland and track at Hiran Farm all north of the existing A465 Trunk Road. (Plots 2/8b, 2/8c, 2/8d, 2/8i, 2/8j and 2/8k).

#### IN THE COMMUNITIES OF SIRHOWY AND RASSAU IN THE COUNTY BOROUGH OF BLAENAU GWENT

Part of the existing A465 Trunk Road and verge south of Hiran Farm extending to Rassau Roundabout; pasture land and hay barn, part of Hiran Farm; the right to enter, including vehicular access, upon grassland at Hiran Farm north of the existing A465 Trunk Road. (Plots 2/1u, 2/1x, 2/8 and 2/8a).

#### IN THE COMMUNITY OF RASSAU IN THE COUNTY BOROUGH OF BLAENAU GWENT

Grazing land, workshop, yard and water courses at The Wells Farm, north of the A465 Trunk Road, south of and part of Bridleway 332/59/1; grazing land and telecommunication mast part of The Wells Farm and south of the Unit 26 Rassau Industrial Estate; pasture land, north of the vacant office premises known as Access465 and south of Unit 27, Rassau Industrial Estate; part of Restricted Byway 332/65/1; part of existing A465 Trunk Road and verges south and south-east of Hiran Farm. (Plots 2/1i, 2/1j, 2/1k, 2/1l, 2/1m,

2/1n, 2/1p, 2/1q, 2/1r, 2/1t, 2/1v, 2/1w, 2/1z, 2/1aa, 2/1ab, 2/1ac, 2/1ad and 2/1ae).

Part of the unclassified dual carriageway, verge, footway, grassland and cattle grid north of Rassau Roundabout, part of Brynserth Road and part of Alan Davies Way, including circulatory carriage of roundabout; verge and grassland east of Hirgan Farm at Rassau Roundabout; part of steeply sloping grassland south of Units 26 and 27 Rassau Industrial Estate including part of, and land north of, Drovers' Way (Animal Walk); access track north-east of the properties known as Coates Row and rough grassland west of the vacant office premises known as Access465 and part of Restricted Byway 332/65/1; (Plots 2/2e, 2/2f, 2/2g, 2/2h, 2/2i, 2/2j, 2/2k, 2/2l, 2/2m, 2/2n, 2/2p, 2/2q, 2/2r, 2/2s, 2/2t, 2/2u, 2/2v and 2/2x).

Part of footpath 332/66/1 and grazing land at Hirgan Farm west, north-west and north of Rassau Roundabout on the existing A465 Trunk Road. (Plots 2/8e, 2/8f, 2/8g and 2/8h).

Grassland north of existing A465 Trunk Road and south of dual carriageway leading to Alan Davies Way at Beaufort Wells; the right to enter, including vehicular access, upon grassland, verge and the Nant Melyn water course north of the existing A465 Trunk Road and north-east of the Rassau Roundabout, for all purposes connected with construction and maintenance of drainage works. 1. The Welsh Ministers have prepared in draft 'The Welsh Ministers (The Neath To Abergavenny Trunk Road (A465) (Abergavenny To Hirwaun Dualling And Slip Roads) And East Of Abercynon To East Of Dowlais Trunk Road (A4060) And Cardiff To Glan Conwy Trunk Road (A470) (Connecting Roads) (Brynmawr To Tredegar)) Compulsory Purchase Order 201-', under sections 239, 240, 246, 250, 254 and 260 of the Highways Act 1980 and under section 2 of, and paragraph 1(1)(b), (3) and (4) of Part 1 of Schedule 2 to the Acquisition of Land Act 1981. The Welsh Ministers are about to make this Order and if made the Order will authorise them to purchase compulsorily the land and new rights described below for the purpose of: -

- (g) the construction of the new trunk road from Brynmawr to Tredegar, all in the communities of Sirhowy, Rassau, Beaufort and Brynmawr North in the County Borough of Blaenau Gwent, in pursuance of the Neath To Abergavenny Trunk Road (A465) (Abergavenny To Hirwaun Dualling And Slip Roads) And East Of Abercynon To East Of Dowlais Trunk Road (A4060) And Cardiff To Glan Conwy Trunk Road (A470) (Connecting Roads) Order 1999, as amended by the Neath To Abergavenny Trunk Road (A465) (Abergavenny To Hirwaun Dualling And Slip Roads) And East Of Abercynon To East Of Dowlais Trunk Road (A4060) And Cardiff To Glan Conwy Trunk Road (A470) (Connecting Roads) Order 1999, (Brynmawr To Tredegar) (Amendment) Order 201-;
- (h) the construction and improvement of highways and the provision of new means of

access to premises in the said Communities in the said County Borough in pursuance of The Neath To Abergavenny Trunk Road (A465) (Abergavenny To Hirwaun Dualling And Slip Roads) And East Of Abercynon To East Of Dowlais Trunk Road (A4060) And Cardiff To Glan Conwy Trunk Road (A470) (Connecting Roads) (Brynmawr To Tredegar) (Side Roads) Order 201-;

- (i) the improvement of the Trunk Road in the said Communities in the said County Borough
- (j) the execution of works on watercourses in connection with the construction of the new trunk road and the construction and improvement of other highways and the execution of other works mentioned above;
- (k) use by the Welsh Ministers in connection with such improvement of highways and the execution of other works mentioned above; and
- (l) the mitigation of any adverse effects which the existence or use of certain of the highways proposed to be constructed or improved will have on the surroundings thereof.

3. If no relevant objection (as defined in paragraph 4(6) of Schedule 1 to the Acquisition of Land Act



1981) is made, or if all objections so made are withdrawn, or if the Welsh Ministers are satisfied that every objection so made relates to matters of compensation which can be dealt with by the Lands Tribunal, the Welsh Ministers may make the Compulsory Purchase Order with or without modifications.

4. In any other case where a relevant objection has been made which has not been withdrawn or disregarded the Welsh Ministers are required, before making the Order, either to

- (i) cause a Public Local Inquiry to be held;
- (ii) afford to the objector an opportunity of appearing before and being heard by a person appointed by the Welsh Ministers for the purpose; or
- (iii) with the consent of the objector, follow a written representations procedure.

5. The Welsh Ministers may then, after considering the objection and the report of the person who held the Inquiry or hearing or considered the written representations, make the Order with or without modifications.

6. Any objection to the draft Order must be made in writing and addressed to Orders, Transport, Welsh Government, Cathays Park, Cardiff CF10 3NQ before 27 October 2011 and should state the title of the Order, the reference BZ 910182C-312-qA901627, the grounds of objection and the objector's address and interests in the land. **Please Note:** Your correspondence will be considered by the Project Team and we may need to consult with people and organisations outside of the Welsh Government. As part of the process of consulting with others we may pass information to them, including information you have given us and your personal data. We will however, only disclose your personal details where it is necessary to do so to enable us to deal with issues you have brought to our attention. Where a Trunk Road Scheme becomes the subject of a Public Inquiry (PI), all correspondence is copied to the Inspector of the Inquiry and is kept in the PI Library and is publicly available.

1. The Welsh Ministers have published the above-named draft compulsory purchase order, which, if made, will authorise the compulsory acquisition of land and rights over land which forms part of a common, as defined in section 19 of the Acquisition of Land Act 1981 (“the 1981 Act”). The areas of common land to be acquired are described in the First Schedule hereto (“the First Schedule land”) and are shown coloured pink on the plan referred to in paragraph 5 below. The areas of common land over which rights are to be acquired are described in the Second Schedule hereto and are shown coloured blue on the said plan. The areas of land to be given in exchange for the First Schedule land are described in the Third Schedule hereto and shown coloured green on the said plan.

2. Section 19 of, and paragraph 6 of Schedule 3 to, the 1981 Act contain

provisions to the effect that the Order shall be subject to special parliamentary procedure insofar as it authorises the purchase of land or acquisition of rights over land forming part of a common unless the Secretary of State certifies that he is satisfied

- (a) as regards the purchase of land forming part of a common

“that there has been or will be given in exchange for such land, other land, not being less in area and being equally advantageous to the persons, if any, entitled to rights of common or other rights, and to the public, and that the land given in exchange has been or will be vested in the persons in whom the land purchased was vested, and subject to the like rights, trusts and incidents as attach to the land purchased”

and

- (b) as regards the acquisition of rights over land forming part of a common

“that the land when burdened with that right, will be no less advantageous to those persons in whom it is vested and other persons, if any, entitled to rights of common or other rights, and to the public, than it was before”

3. The Secretary of State's functions under section 19 of the 1981 Act were transferred to the National Assembly for Wales by the National Assembly for Wales (Transfer of Functions) Order 1999 (SI 1999/672) and has subsequently been transferred to the Welsh Ministers by virtue of paragraph 30(1) of Schedule 11 to the Government of Wales Act 2006. By virtue of paragraph 33(4) of that Schedule, any instrument made in the exercise of those functions is subject to special Assembly procedure as specified by Standing Order 28 of the National Assembly for Wales, unless the Welsh Ministers are satisfied on those matters set out in paragraph 6(1) of Schedule 3 to the 1981 Act and certify accordingly.

4. The Welsh Ministers are required to give formal notice of the intention to issue a certificate before reaching a decision, to give an opportunity for representations or objections to be made. They hereby give such notice. Any representations and objections in relation to this intention should be made in writing and addressed to The Planning Inspectorate, Crown Buildings, Cathays Park, Cardiff CF10 3NQ before 27 October 2011 quoting reference BZ 910182C-312-qA901627.

5. A plan showing the areas of common land to be acquired, the areas of common land over which rights are to be acquired and the areas of land to be given in exchange may be seen at all reasonable hours at the following venues:-
