We make special efforts through our International Learning Opportunities programme to promote Welsh values of equality, inclusion and diversity while helping to create a safe, inclusive and diverse environment that encourages a culture of respect and equality for everyone regardless of their sexual orientation or gender identity. I would be more than happy to meet with you at your convenience to hear your views and address any concerns that you may have.
