Yes, I just had an update through from the site which confirms Tony's comments.

`The status is still the same at the moment in as much as we're being driven by the other two sites. I can confirm that there has not been any combustion or steam raising activities whatsoever since the G59 in March 18.

There are a number of issues relating to improvements to fuel handling etc which need to be rolled out across all 3 sites with Barry being the final site planned to go into operation.

There is no talk of bringing any waste wood to site anytime soon and operationally we are driven by the start up dates of Hull and then Boston so even without any major issues we are still likely looking at a few months.

As soon as anything changes I will ensure you are kept informed at every stage'.

Nadia, when we last spoke to them in mid-July hot commissioning was scheduled for October 2019.

There seems to have been some slippage since then as we have not received some documentation that was expected at the end of August (as far as I am aware) and there remain some outstanding pre-operational conditions for final submission. Some plant testing has been carried out to check that the noise mitigation modifications has been effective and also to implement some fuel handling modifications based upon experience at the sister plants in England.

I think that's all the latest information we have unless Richard has anything to add.
