ATISN 13596 – Pelvic Health Co-ordinators

Thank you for your correspondence received on 21 November to which we are responding as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000). Following on from your previous request (ATISN 13553 – £1m Allocated to Women's Health), we have interpreted your requested as follows:

Regarding Pelvic Health Co-ordinators

- *How many posts have been appointed,*
- *Which health boards they have been allocated to,*
- *How many more are due to be appointed, the health boards they will go to and in what approximate timescale.*
- *A break down how much each health board has been allocated since May 2018 when the money was pledged.*

I have provided the information you requested in a table below.
