ATISN 13664: EFSM Percentage

Thank you for your e-mail to the Welsh Government requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000), received on 20 December. I have interpreted your request as follows:

You have requested

How schools grouped according to EFSM percentage (3 year average) performed in the core subjects in 2018/2019 GCSE.

The value of Welsh first language to the Level 2 inclusive score for Welsh medium schools.

Looking at secondary and middle schools who entered pupils for GCSE in 2018/2019.

For English medium and Welsh medium (broad definition) schools separately.

Grouping schools by EFSM percentage: - Less than 10% EFSM, over 10% and less than 15% EFSM, Over 15% and up to and including the highest EFSM % for a WM school this year (to make sure the third group is as fair a comparison as possible. From that point on, EM schools at 10% intervals. The last group at 30% plus.

The number of pupils in each group.

The percentage level 2 pass rate for

- *Maths (any)*
- *Maths (numeracy)*
- *Maths.*
- *Science*
- *English language.*
- *Welsh first language.*
- *Level 2 inclusive Eng/Welsh Maths (any)*
- *Level 2 inclusive but without Welsh first language in the calculation.*
- *5 A*-A GCSE passes.*
