ATISN 13818: 18-19 GCSE Results by EFSM Banding

Thank you for your request to the Welsh Government for information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) which I received on 24 February. You requested the following regarding how Gwynedd LEA schools performed in the core subjects in 2018/2019 GCSE exams.

To ascertain the value of Welsh first language to the Level 2 inclusive score for Welsh medium schools.

Looking at secondary and middle schools which entered pupils for GCSE in 2018/2019.

For English medium and Welsh medium (broad definition but including schools if pupils predominantly entered for Welsh first language GCSE) schools separately.

Grouping schools by EFSM percentage: - Up to 5% EFSM, over 5% and up to 10% EFSM, over 10% and up to 15% EFSM, over 15% and up to 20% EFSM, over 20% and up to 25% EFSM. The last group at 30% plus. (Some of these groups will not apply in Gwynedd.)

- *The number of pupils in each group.*
- *The number of schools in each group.*
- *The percentage Level 2 pass rate for:*
 - *Maths (any/best)*
 - *Maths (numeracy)*
 - *Maths.*
 - *Science*
 - *English language*
 - *Welsh first language*
 - *Level 2 inclusive English/Welsh Maths (any)*
 - *Level 2 inclusive but without Welsh first language in the calculation*
 - *5 A*-A GCSE passes*

The information you requested is attached at Annex 1.
