ATISN reference 13860: Cardiff Bay Barrage and Reservoir Gate Times

Thank you for your request, which I received on 11th March.

You asked for:

- Opening / closing times when reservoirs released water into rivers.
- Data relating to Cardiff Bay Barrage specifically gates opening / closing and operational factors.

Following a search of our paper and electronic records, I have established that the information you require is not held by the Welsh Government. Supporting information would not be held by Welsh Government as we do not manage either of these assets.

However, I believe that Dwr Cymru could be responsible for the Reservoir and Cardiff Harbour Authority for the Cardiff Bay Barrage information that you are seeking. You can ask them for the information at:
