## Corona Virus (COVID-19) – Planning Inspectorate Wales Update 21<sup>st</sup> April 2020

The on-going controls in relation to the Corona Virus pandemic, continue to have an impact on Planning Inspectorate Wales' day to day business. We are keeping the situation under daily review and are working with Local Planning Authorities (LPA), Appellants and Agents to progress casework as far as possible.
