ATISN 13937 - Native and fluent Welsh speakers by school

Thank you for your request to the Welsh Government for information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) received on 28 April. You requested:

For each primary school in Wales separately:

- *Percentage of pupils who speak Welsh at home (this is your clarification of 'native')*
- *Percentage of pupils who do not speak Welsh at home but are fluent Welsh speakers (this is your clarification of 'fluent')*
- *Both of these categories separately and a combined percentage of the two.*

Welsh Government holds this information and is attached at **Annex 1**.
