Mae Gweinidogion Cymru, sef yr awdurdod traffig ar gyfer y darn perthnasol o Gefnffordd yr A55, wedi eu bodloni y dylid cyfyngu ar draffig a/neu ei wahardd ar ddarnau penodedig o'r gefnffordd oherwydd gwaith y bwriedir ei wneud ar y ffordd neu gerllaw iddi ac oherwydd y tebygolrwydd o berygl i'r cyhoedd ar y ffordd neu gerllaw iddi yn ystod cyfnodau o wyntoedd cryfion.

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the A55 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on specified lengths of the trunk road should be restricted and/or prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road and because of the likelihood of a danger to the public on or near the road during periods of high winds.

Mae Gweinidogion Cymru, felly, drwy arfer y pwerau a roddir iddynt gan adrannau 14(1), (4) a (7) o Ddeddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrdd 1984(1), yn gwneud y Gorchymyn hwn.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 14(1), (4) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Commencement and Interpretation

1. Enw'r Gorchymyn hwn yw Gorchymyn Cefnffordd yr A55 (Cyffordd 1 (Cylchfan Kingsland), Caergybi, Ynys Môn i fan i'r dwyrain o Gyffordd 11 (Cyfnewidfa Llys y Gwynt), Bangor, Gwynedd) (Cyfyngiadau a Gwaharddiad Traffig Dros Dro) 2020 a daw i rym ar 26 Mehefin 2020.

1. The title of this Order is the A55 Trunk Road (Junction 1 (Kingsland Roundabout), Holyhead, Isle of Anglesey to east of Junction 11 (Llys y Gwynt Interchange), Bangor, Gwynedd) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions & Prohibition) Order 2020 and it comes into force on 26 June 2020.

Yn rhinwedd O.S. 1999/672, ac adran 162 o Ddeddf Llywodraeth Cymru 2006 (p.32) a pharagraff 30 o Atodlen 11 iddi, mae'r pwerau hyn yn arferadwy bellach gan Weinidogion Cymru o ran Cymru.

2. Yn y Gorchymyn hwn—

ystyr “cerbyd esempt” (“*exempted vehicle*”) yw:

- (a) unrhyw gerbyd sy'n cael ei ddefnyddio at y dibenion a ddisgrifir yn adran 87 o Ddeddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrdd 1984(2); a
- (b) unrhyw gerbyd sy'n cael ei ddefnyddio at ddibenion y llynges, y fyddin neu'r llu awyr ac sy'n cael ei yrru gan berson sydd am y tro yn ddarostyngedig i orchmynion aelod o luoedd arfog y Goron, sy'n aelod o'r lluoedd arbennig—
 - (i) ac sydd wedi ei hyfforddi i yrru ar gyflymderau uchel ac sy'n gweithredu wrth ymateb, neu wrth ymarfer ymateb, i argyfwng diogelwch gwladol; neu
 - (ii) at ddiben hyfforddi person i yrru cerbydau ar gyflymderau uchel;

ystyr “cyfnod y gwaith” (“*works period*”) yw cyfnodau ysbeidiol sy'n dechrau am 00:01 o'r gloch ar 26 Mehefin 2020 ac sy'n dod i ben pan gaiff yr arwyddion traffig dros dro ar gyfer pob cyfnod gwaith eu symud ymaith;

ystyr “y gefnffordd” (“*the trunk road*”) yw Cefnffordd Caer i Fangor yr A55 a Chefnffordd Llundain i Gaerdybi yr A55;

ystyr “lluoedd arbennig” (“*special forces*”) yw'r unedau hynny o'r lluoedd arfog y mae Cyfarwyddwr y Lluoedd Arbennig yn gyfrifol am gynnal eu galluoedd neu sydd am y tro yn ddarostyngedig i reolaeth weithredol y Cyfarwyddwr hwnnw.

Cyfyngiadau a Gwaharddiad

3. Ni chaiff neb, yn ystod cyfnod y gwaith nac yn ystod cyfnodau o wyntoedd cryfion, yrru unrhyw gerbyd modur yn gyflymach na 30 mya ar y darnau o'r gefnffordd a ddisgrifir yn yr Atodlen i'r Gorchymyn hwn.

4. Ni chaiff neb, yn ystod cyfnod y gwaith nac yn ystod cyfnodau o wyntoedd cryfion, yrru unrhyw gerbyd modur yn gyflymach na 40 mya ar y darnau o'r gefnffordd a ddisgrifir yn yr Atodlen i'r Gorchymyn hwn.

5. Ni chaiff neb, yn ystod cyfnod y gwaith nac yn ystod cyfnodau o wyntoedd cryfion, yrru unrhyw gerbyd modur yn gyflymach na 50 mya ar y darnau o'r gefnffordd a ddisgrifir yn yr Atodlen i'r Gorchymyn hwn.

(2) Diwygiwyd adran 87 gan baragraff 55 o Atodlen 1 i Ddeddf y Gwasanaethau Tân ac Achub 2004 (p.21), paragraff 42 o Atodlen 4 i Ddeddf Troseddau Cyfundrefnol Difrifol a'r Heddlu 2005 (p.15), paragraff 29(2) o Atodlen 8 i Ddeddf Troseddau a'r Llysoedd 2013 (p.22) ac adran 50(4) a (5) o Ddeddf Dadreoleiddio 2015 (p.20).

2. In this Order—

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means:

- (a) any vehicle being used for the purposes described in section 87 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(2); and
- (b) any vehicle being used for naval, military or air force purposes and being driven by a person for the time being subject to the orders of a member of the armed forces of the Crown, who is a member of the special forces—
 - (i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving at high speeds; or
 - (ii) for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds;

“special forces” (“*lluoedd arbennig*”) means those units of the armed forces the maintenance of whose capabilities is the responsibility of the Director of Special Forces or which are for the time being subject to the operational command of that Director;

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the A55 Chester to Bangor Trunk Road and the A55 London to Holyhead Trunk Road;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means intermittent periods commencing at 00:01 hours on 26 June 2020 and ending when the temporary traffic signs for each period of works are removed.

Restrictions and Prohibition

3. No person may, during the works period or during periods of high winds, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 mph on the lengths of the trunk road described in the Schedule to this Order.

4. No person may, during the works period or during periods of high winds, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 mph on the lengths of the trunk road described in the Schedule to this Order.

5. No person may, during the works period or during periods of high winds, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 mph on the lengths of the trunk road described in the Schedule to this Order.

6. Ni chaiff neb, yn ystod cyfnod y gwaith, yrru unrhyw gerbyd, ac eithrio cerbyd esempt, ar y darnau o'r gefnffordd a bennir yn yr Atodlen i'r Gorchymyn hwn.

Cymhwysio

7.—(1) Nid yw'r cyfyngiadau a'r gwaharddiad yn erthyglau 3, 4, 5 a 6 yn gymwys ond ar yr adegau hynny ac i'r graddau hynny y bydd arwyddion traffig yn eu dangos.

(2) Nid yw unrhyw derfynau cyflymder a osodir gan y Gorchymyn hwn yn gymwys i gerbyd esempt.

Atal Dros Dro

8. Mae unrhyw ddarpariaethau statudol sy'n cyfyngu ar gyflymder cerbydau modur ar y darnau o'r gefnffordd wedi eu hatal dros dro ar yr adegau hynny pan fo'r cyfyngiadau a bennir yn erthyglau 3, 4 a 5 yn gymwys.

Cyfnod Para's Gorchymyn hwn

9. Bydd y Gorchymyn hwn yn para am 18 mis ar y mwyaf.

Llofnodwyd o dan awdurdod y Gweinidog dros yr Economi, Trafnidiaeth a Gogledd Cymru, un o Weinidogion Cymru.

YR ATODLEN

Y darnau o brif gerbydffyrdd tua'r dwyrain a thua'r gorllewin a holl ffyrdd ymuno ac ymadael y gefnffordd sy'n ymestyn o Gyffordd 1 (Cylchfan Kingsland), Caergybi, Ynys Môn hyd at bwynt 800 metr i'r dwyrain o ganolbwynt Cyffordd 11 (Cyfnewidfa Llys y Gwynt), Bangor, Gwynedd.

6. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the lengths of the trunk road described in the Schedule to this Order.

Application

7.—(1) The restrictions and prohibition in articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

(2) No speed limits imposed by this Order apply to an exempted vehicle.

Suspension

8. Any statutory provisions restricting the speed of vehicles on the lengths of the trunk road described in the Schedule to this Order are suspended during such times as the restrictions specified in articles 3, 4 and 5 apply.

Duration of this Order

9. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.

SCHEDULE

The lengths of the main eastbound and westbound carriageways and all slip roads of the trunk road that extend from Junction 1 (Kingsland Roundabout), Holyhead, Isle of Anglesey to a point 800 metres east of the centre-point of Junction 11 (Llys y Gwynt Interchange), Bangor, Gwynedd.

BANGOR, GWYNEDD) (TEMPORARY
TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS & PROHIBITION)
ORDER 2020**

The Welsh Ministers have made an Order under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The temporary Order is required to undertake works on or near the A55 trunk road between Junction 1 (Kingsland Roundabout), Holyhead, Anglesey and Junction 11 (Llys y Gwynt Interchange), Bangor, Gwynedd. It is also required, as a contingency, to safeguard road users on the A55 during periods of high winds on the Britannia Bridge.

The effect of the Order is to temporarily:

- i. impose 30 mph, 40 mph and/or 50 mph speed limits on the lengths of the main eastbound and westbound carriageways and slip roads of the A55 that extend from its junction with Kingsland Roundabout, Holyhead, Isle of Anglesey to a point 800 metres east of the centre-point of Junction 11 (Llys y Gwynt Interchange), Bangor, Gwynedd; and
- ii. prohibit all vehicles, other than those being used by the emergency services and for the works, from proceeding on the lengths of the A55 described above. This provision is included as a contingency against unforeseen events. Any such closures are only expected to be for short periods of time and, whenever possible, will be indicated by advance traffic signs. No diversionary routes will be necessary.

The temporary restrictions and prohibition are expected to come into force at 00:01 hours on 26 June 2020 and will operate as required and when signed for a maximum period of 18 months.

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
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
