2. Who will have access to your data:

The collected information will be accessible by Welsh Government support service teams. System technical administrators will not use your details in any way. Where necessary your information will be passed on to Statutory Bodies such as, but not confined to, Local Authorities or the Gangmasters Licensing Authority so they may contact you about matters concerning the regulation of cockle and mussel fishing.

3. How long are your details kept

The Welsh Government will only retain your personal data for as long as:

- it is needed for the purposes set out in this document
- the law requires us to

4. Your rights

Under the data protection legislation, you have the right:

- to access the personal data the Welsh Government holds on you
- require us to rectify inaccuracies in that data
- to (in certain circumstances) object to or restrict processing
- for (in certain circumstances) your data to be 'erased'
- to lodge a complaint with the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) who is our independent regulator for data protection
