Grants are available to help families on low incomes buy school clothing and equipment.




Learners receiving free school meals can get a Welsh Government grant if they are:

- entering reception class in primary school
- at the start of any of the key stages, e.g. Key Stage 2, Key Stage 3 or Key Stage 4 (primary and secondary)
- aged 4, 7, 11 or 14 in special schools, special needs resource bases or pupil referral units.

Funding for looked after children is available in every school year.









Primary and secondary school children are entitled to £125 for each application.

Children entering Year 7 can apply for £200 to help with the additional costs of starting secondary school.

The fund will cover school uniform, other clothing worn at school such as sports kit, equipment for out-of-schoolhours trips (including outdoor learning), and equipment for activities within the curriculum such as design and technology.
