ATISN 14095 – Funding for National Events in Wales

Thank you for your request, which I received on 30 June 2020 about funding for national events in Wales.

I apologise for the delay in getting the information regarding the Hay Festival and International Eisteddfod, Llangollen. You requested all agreed financial support for these from 1 February 2020 to 30 June 2020.

The information you requested is as follows:

Hay Festival

In April 2020, Welsh Government agreed a two year global sponsorship with Hay Festival of Literature and the Arts. The total value of the sponsorship for 2020 and 2021 is £630,000 (inclusive of VAT) and includes festivals in Wales, Europe, South America and the Middle East.

Llangollen International Eisteddfod

Grant funding of up to £338,200 has been made available to Llangollen International Musical Eisteddfod to support business continuity, including planning and preparations for the 2021 event.
