ATISN 14117 – Welsh Government Warm Homes Arbed 1 scheme – Bryn Carno

Thank you for your request which I received on 6 July 2020 about documentation in relation to the Welsh Government Warm Homes Arbed 1 scheme in Bryn Carno. The information you requested is enclosed, and is summarised below for ease of reference:

- Grant award letter issued by Welsh Government to Caerphilly County Borough Council on 5 December 2012, containing the terms and conditions of the grant award of £130,016 for installing energy efficiency measures in properties in Bryn Carno.
- Meeting notes from the meeting held on 28 January between Lesley Griffiths MS, Minister for Environment, Energy and Rural Affairs, Dawn Bowden MS, Carl Cuss and Welsh Government officials regarding the work carried out in Bryn Carno under the Welsh Government Arbed 1 scheme.
- Notes from further meetings regarding the issues at Bryn Carno. These meetings include:
 - Meeting between Welsh Government United Welsh Housing on 12 February 2020.
 - Meeting between Welsh Government and Caerphilly County Council on 12 March 2020.
 - Meeting between Welsh Government, United Welsh Housing Association, Caerphilly County Borough Council and Rockwool on 25 June 2020.
- Extract of advice sent to Lesley Griffiths MS, Minister for Environment, Energy and Rural Affairs in June regarding the issues at Bryn Carno.

Officials are unable to locate an electronic copy of the grant award letter issued by Welsh Government to United Welsh Housing Association. This may be held as a hard copy in our offices at Cathays Park, Cardiff, however, officials are unable to confirm this at present as we are currently working remotely due to the Covid-19 pandemic.
