ATISN 14127 – Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy (BSE) Burial Locations

- Thank you for your request which I received on 8th July 2020. You asked for:
- All locations of known BSE burial sites to including the following:
 - Location plans.
 - Site plans to include extent of burial sites.
 - Central grid references.
 - Dates of operation (start and end).
 - Current owners and owners when burial occurred.
 - Number of cattle in each site and/or total weight (e.g. tonnes) in each Site.

As outlined to you previously, there have been difficulties in accessing the paper versions of older files, due to the unprecedented difficulties placed upon us in the current pandemic. Thank you for your patience with us through this process, but I am now able to confirm that following a search of our paper and electronic records, I have established that the information you require is not held by the Welsh Government.

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response.
