Thank you for your request which I received on 26 September 2020. You asked:

*Up until 26th September, when was the last time the First Minister visited North Wales?*

*By North Wales I mean Anglesey, Gwynedd, Conwy, Denbighshire, Flintshire or Wrexham.*

The impact of the pandemic and the Welsh Government regulations introduced to control the spread of the virus and protect people's health (since 23 March) have meant that very few Ministerial visits to any location have taken place while the pandemic has been ongoing.
