Request for Information – ATISN 14438

Thank you for your request for information which I received on 17 October. You asked:

1. What provisions are in place at Cardiff Airport to check the home addresses of passengers, and how long have they been in place?
2. Are police, or any other relevant authority, present at the Airport and tasked with identifying passengers who reside in an area outside the Vale of Glamorgan?
3. Since the lockdown began in South Wales councils bordering the Vale of Glamorgan, has any passenger been turned away from the Airport because they travelled there in violation of the restrictions?
4. What Welsh Assembly member has responsibility for the relationship with Cardiff Airport?

I can confirm we hold some information captured by your request. For question 4, the Minister for Economy, Transport and North Wales has responsibility for the relationship with Cardiff Airport.

For questions 1, 2 and 3, the Welsh Government does not hold the information. Border Force, a law-enforcement command within the Home Office, is responsible for frontline border control operations at air, sea and rail ports in the United Kingdom.
