The advice will be based on the work carried out by the Transforming Cancer Services programme to date and all the work over recent months, including the ongoing work of the Velindre Futures task and finish groups.

What does this mean for you?

As part of the work, the Nuffield Trust will speak with a number of individuals who hold a formal leadership position or role within the Trust or within our partner Health Boards i.e. individuals in posts which lead or represent a body of staff/opinion, either on behalf of their organisation, service, region or nationally.

The Nuffield Trust have asked that these individuals speak from the perspective of that role, in addition to any personal views they may have. They are also keen to hear from all staff as we have explained that there is a real appetite within the Cancer Centre to engage in this process. In order to manage this effectively, they have requested that people's views are fed through the existing structures within the Cancer Centre e.g. *via* professional
