### Request for Information – ATISN 14749

I wrote to you on 19 January regarding your Freedom of Information request and to outline my understanding of the information you have requested. As I have not heard anything further from you, my search for information has been on that basis.

### Information requested

1. Information showing any decision made by or on behalf of any Minister that demonstrates the decision(s) as to whether a grant should be paid in relation to the restrictions imposed on 4 December and another grant paid in respect of the restrictions imposed from 20 December.

### Our Response

I confirm the Welsh Government holds information caught by your request. I have concluded, however, that the information is exempt from disclosure under Section 21 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, information otherwise available. The information you have requested is available on the Decision Reports pages of the Welsh Government website at <https://gov.wales/decision-reports2020>. Specifically, the information is under the headings 'Support for business - 30 December 2020' and 'Covid-19 Economic Resilience Fund - 14 December 2020'.
