Thank you for your request which I received on 15 May 2021. You asked the following:

how many people in Wales, who have been offered a Covid-19 vaccination, have declined the offer?

The Welsh Government does not hold information on people who have been offered a COVID-19 vaccine, but declined the offer.

Information on the numbers who have declined the offer of a vaccine can be requested from Public Health Wales (PHW). PHW publish data on their [Rapid COVID-29 surveillance dashboard](#), showing the number of people who have received the vaccination and also the percentage uptake within each group. The high levels of uptake indicate that the proportion of people who have declined the vaccine offer so far is low.

PHW's [Public engagement survey](#) for 1st to 7th March 2021, also showed that 6 per cent of people don't want to be vaccinated, with a further 1 per cent saying they were unsure.

If you are dissatisfied with the Welsh Government's handling of your request, you can ask for an internal review within 40 working days of the date of this response. Requests for an internal review should be addressed to the Welsh Government's Freedom of Information Officer at:
