## **ATISN 15259 Monuments and Street Names Audit**

### **Information requested**

Thank you for your request which I received on 21 June 2021. You asked for:

The budget, actual or provisional, allocated to implement the recommendations from the Monuments and Street Names Audit. I have interpreted this to mean *The Slave Trade and the British Empire: an audit of commemoration in Wales*.

### **Our response**

The section in [The Slave Trade and the British Empire: an audit of commemoration in Wales](#) headed 'next steps' proposed that a second stage is undertaken to consider the issues arising from the audit. The audit sought to capture information, rather than provide a set of answers or specific recommendations.

In addition to the audit, this second stage will also be informed by the Senedd's Culture, Welsh Language and Communities Committee inquiry [Set in Stone? A report on who gets remembered in public spaces](#). No budget, actual or provisional, has been allocated to this work at this time. This will be considered as part of the scoping for the second stage, and will be met from existing budgets.

Future work as a result of the audit will also take into account the actions identified in the [Race Equality Action Plan: An Anti-racist Wales](#). The consultation on this document runs until 15 July 2021.
