Information requested

Thank you for your request which I received on 2 September 2021. You asked for:

Information on any invitations to hospitality events that the Chief Fire and Rescue Adviser and his staff received from commercial companies as part of the Emergency Services Show at the NEC on 7-8 September.

You specifically asked :-

- 1) what invitations have been received by commercial companies for the Chief Advisor or any their staff to attended hospitality events funded by the company during the period of the above Emergency Services Show?
- 2) what invitations referred to in 1 above have been accepted by the Chief Fire Advisor or any of their staff?
- 3) please provide the name of the commercial company and the hospitality event to which each invitation relates to?
- 4) what is the estimated individual value of each hospitality event to which the Chief Fire Advisor or any of their staff have been invited to participate in?
- 5) please provide a copy of the receipt of hospitality policy.

Our response

In answer to your first question, the Chief Fire and Rescue Adviser for Wales and his staff (the Assistant Fire and Rescue Adviser for Wales, and the Crown Premises Inspector for
