Further to the Inspector's request in your letter of 16 August 2021, I attach the following documents:

- A signed and completed planning obligation / Unilateral Undertaking (text and plan attached in separate files);
- A Statement of Common Ground relating to the Planning Obligation / Unilateral Undertaking;
- A Statement of Common Ground relating to the Planning Conditions submitted to the Planning Inspectorate on 28 July 2021.

All parties have contributed to the Statement of Common Ground (SoCG) relating to the Planning Conditions and the SoCG shows the different parties' position as tracked changes and shows whether RES agrees or disagrees with that position. The final SoCG has been sent to all parties for review and Bridgend CBC (BCBC) have confirmed they are in agreement with it. While no confirmation has been received from Neath Port Talbot CBC (NPTCBC) or Natural Resources Wales (NRW), we believe that we have accurately represented all parties' representations in the SoCG.
