

We would urgently ask that you don't allow another large proposed solar farm in our small village of Llanedi where there is already two solar farms. Nature is in more trouble now than at any other time in human history, with extinction looming over one million species of plants and animals, scientists have said today in the UN first comprehensive report on biodiversity.

It is all because of humans, but it is not too late to fix the problem. Species loss is accelerating to a rate tens or hundreds times faster than in the past, the report said.
