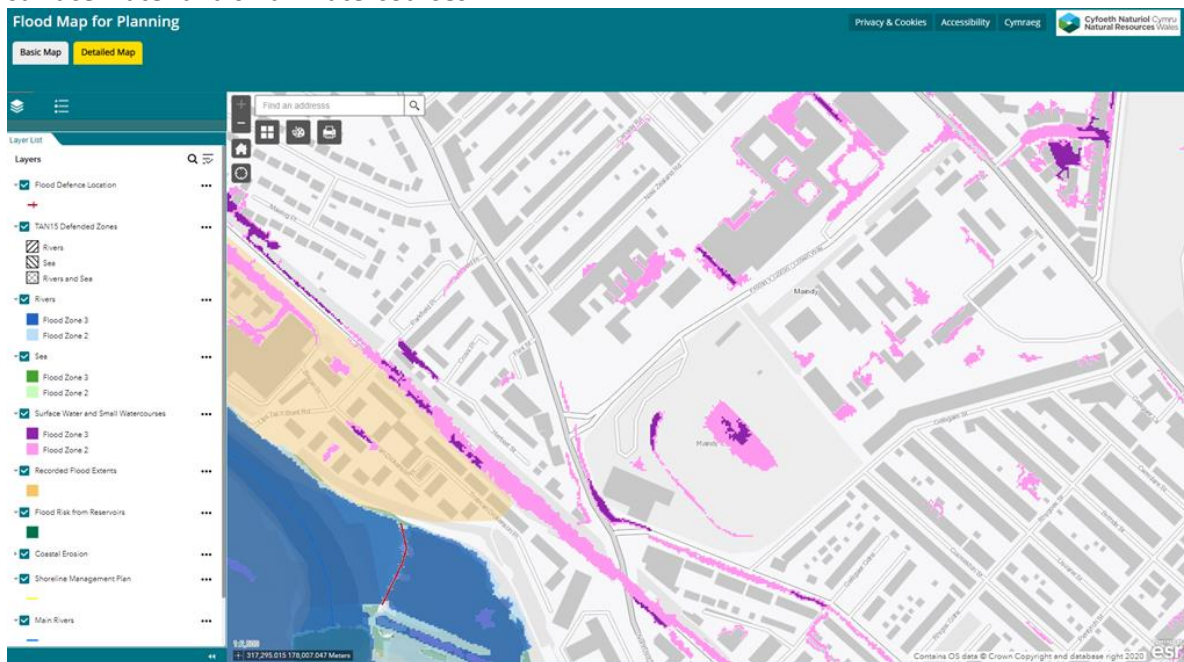

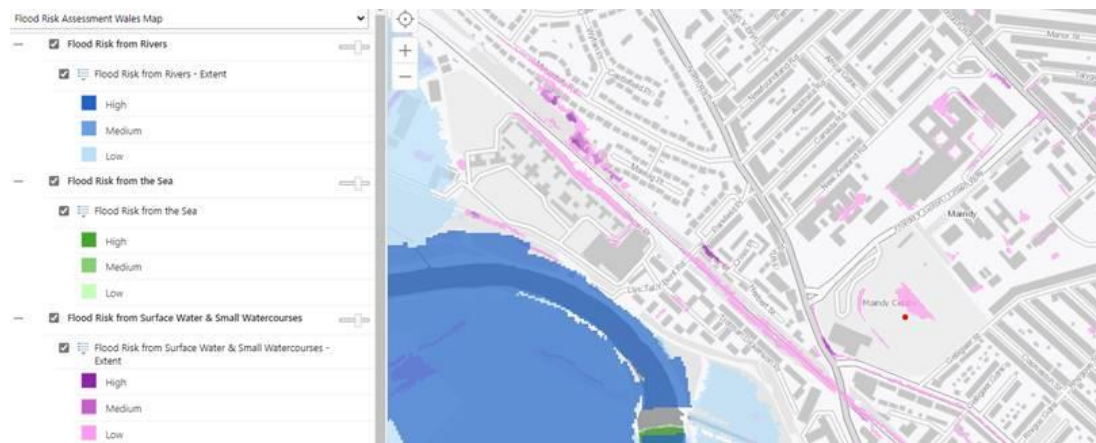
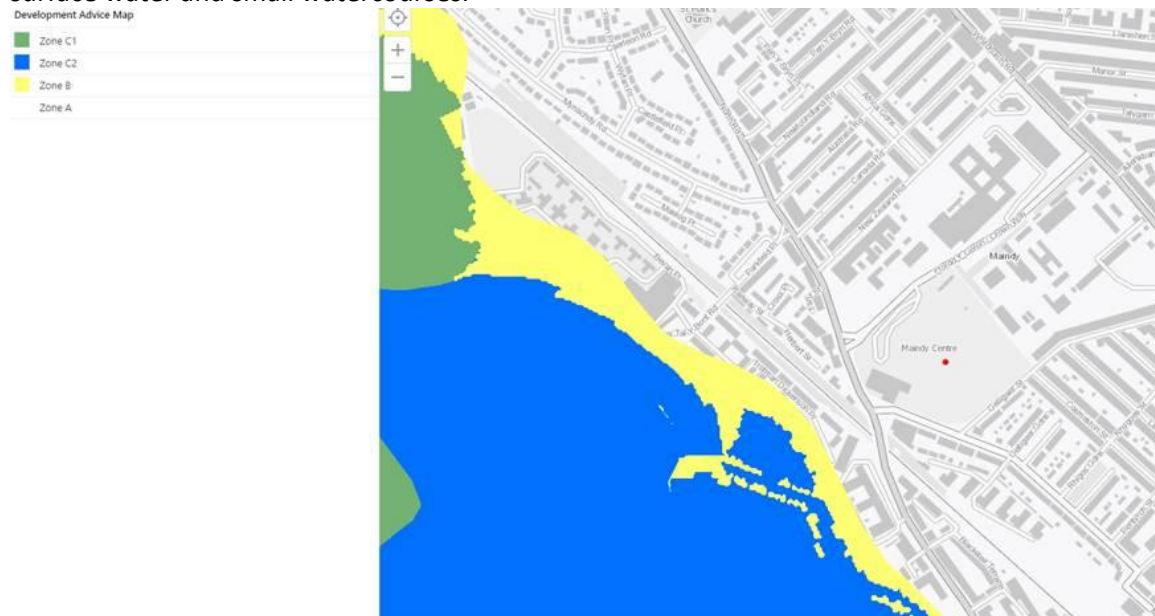


With regards to flood zones there is some presence of surface water on the sites in both the current and future Natural Resource Wales maps, which can be seen below.

In this new future flood map for planning there are localised areas of **flood 2 and 3 zones** related to **surface water and small watercourses**.



The images below show the current **development advice map** shows the site is in **Zone A**, and the **flood risk assessment Wales map** shows the site has some localised areas of '**Low**' flood risk from surface water and small watercourses.

Hopefully you will remember me, although I only think we have met once since I started work in [Redacted] team on the Education MIM programme? I'm writing to all local authorities and colleges with MIM Education projects in response to the recent '*Technical Advice Note (TAN) 15: Development, flooding and coastal erosion*' note and correspondence to all Local Authority Chief Executives and Local Planning Authority Heads of Planning (WG ref MA-JJ-3967-21) from the Minister of Climate Change.

You may have noted in the Minister's correspondence that the implementation date for the updated TAN 15 guidance is set for 1st June 2023 and builds on advice previously issued in the 2004 version of TAN 15 and the Development Advice Map (which does not include climate change allowances), as well as Technical Advice Note 14: Coastal Planning. The updated TAN 15 is accompanied by the Flood Map for Planning, which builds on the Flood Risk Assessment Wales map and includes allowances for climate change.

The MIM Education team are working with the WG Planning Team to establish the potential impact on the programme and need to establish which sites will sit in the new Zone 3 (Flood Map for Planning) under the updated TAN 15 guidance. Could you please confirm to us:

- The post code and address of the preferred site for the MIM project (if known or is not part of a statutory consultation); and
- Under which flood zone your project/s are sited in, for the current and future TAN 15 guidance.

*If you have a number of sits in a single project or multiple projects in the MIM Education pipeline can you please ensure each site is identified.

Cathays High School

At its meeting on 14 October 2021 Cardiff Council Cabinet agreed proposals to:

- Increase the capacity of Cathays High School from 1,072 places (5.5 forms of entry with 247 sixth form places) to 1,450 places (8 Forms of Entry with 250 sixth form places) from September 2023;
- Replace the Cathays High School buildings with new build accommodation on the Maindy Centre site adjacent to Crown Way and North Road;
- Expand the current Specialist Resource Base (SRB) for learners with Autism Spectrum Condition (ASC) from 16 to 50 places in purpose built accommodation in the new school buildings.

The approval is subject to the Charity Commission's consent in relation to the Maindy site being held in a charitable trust.

The Cabinet considered the proposals, the statutory objections submitted and the local authority response thereon.

The concerns raised are summarised in the objection report together with the response from the Council. It was considered that responses made by the Council answered the issues raised.

Publication of Legal Statutory Notices: The Expansion and Redevelopment of Cathays High School

A report was considered by Cardiff Council's Cabinet on 17 June 2021 which set out recommendations following a public consultation that took place earlier in the year on proposals regarding the expansion and redevelopment of Cathays High School.

The Cabinet agreed for the Council to progress to the next stage and issue a legal Statutory Notice to:

- Increase the capacity of Cathays High School from 1,072 places (5.5 Forms of Entry with 247 sixth form places) to 1,450 places (8 Forms of Entry with 250 sixth form places) from September 2023
- Replace the Cathays High School buildings with new build accommodation on the Maindy Centre site adjacent to Crown Way and North Road
- Expand the current Specialist Resource Base (SRB) for learners with Autism Spectrum Condition from 16 to 50 places in purpose-built accommodation in the new school buildings

The statutory notice is live from 29 June 2021 and allows a period of 28 days for formal objections to the proposals up to and including 26 July 2021.

21st Century School

We wrote to you previously regarding the Council's public consultation on the proposed redevelopment and expansion of Cathays High School, which is part of Cardiff's 21st Century Schools Programme.

A report on the consultation will be considered by the Council Cabinet at its meeting on 17 June 2021.

The report informs Cabinet of the responses received during the consultation, the issues raised, the Council's response to these and recommendations on the way forward. The report also identifies and addresses concerns raised in the consultation, in particular uncertainty around the location/ layout of the new build school and the potential impact on open access space.

Further work has been undertaken to produce an indicative red line boundary map for the proposed school site which takes account of the views expressed.

This indicative map is available to view on the Council website at www.cardiff.gov.uk/cathayshighproposal and identifies the open access space that would be available, the retained leisure centre and BMX track areas outside of the development boundary, the required land for the school and remaining community open access land. The map identifies a large area of community space, outside of the school and leisure centre boundary of c13,500m² which would be retained. This represents an increase in unrestricted open access space available for use by the local community.

The open access space areas would be in addition to the facilities which would be provided within the boundary of the school that would be available to the community outside of school hours.

Further consideration of the layout of the site would be necessary at the design stage.

In the report the Cabinet is recommended to authorise officers to publish a statutory notice to:

- Expand Cathays High School from 1,072 places (5.5 Forms of Entry with 247 sixth form places) to 1,450 places (8 Forms of Entry with 250 sixth form places), from September 2023
- Replace the Cathays High School buildings with new build accommodation on the Maindy Centre site adjacent to Crown Way and North Road
- Expand the current Specialist Resource Base (SRB) for learners with Autism Spectrum Condition from 16 to 50 places in purpose-built accommodation in the new school buildings

As part of the Cardiff's Band B 21st Century Schools programme, the Council is consulting on proposals to meet increased demand for secondary school and additional learning needs places.

The Council is proposing to:

- Expand Cathays High School from 1,072 places (5.5 Forms of Entry with 247 sixth form places) to 1,450 places (8 Forms of Entry with 250 sixth form places), from September 2023;
- Replace the Cathays High School buildings with new build accommodation on the Maindy Centre site adjacent to Crown Way and North Road;
- Expand the current Specialist Resource Base (SRB) for learners with Autism Spectrum Condition from 16 to 50 places in purpose-built accommodation in the new school buildings;
- Upgrade community facilities in Cathays and Gabalfa through the significantly enhanced school facilities being made available for shared use with the wider local community;
- Provide space for the local community to continue to have access to off-road open spaces for informal leisure use, recognising this is the current use at the Maindy site.

Comms have advised that the quote provided is accurate and was signed off by [Redacted] and [Redacted].

Points to advise MfEWL:

Generally:

- Cardiff Council are dependent on WG's capital contribution to build the new school under the 21st Century Schools Programme as we are with any new build.
- The Maindee cycling track needs to move to provide the space required to build the school in an area of the city where is it considerably build up it also negates the need to acquire land which is costly in the city.
- The Maindee cycling track will be replaced with a new velodrome in Cardiff with enhanced facilities.
- In summary, the new facility will be located and developed to support the growth of cycling in the City and beyond. The development will include a purpose built velodrome with modern facilities including a club house and spectator stand along with a 1km closed road circuit and a large format bike shop.

On Funding:

- The Education Department of Cardiff Council have therefore agreed to provide a capital contribution to support the new velodrome build as it is required as a consequence of the new school build.
- The position is that it is the Education Department of Cardiff Council that will provide a contribution to the authority's Economic Development department, who will deliver the scheme, this is reflected in the statement *The proposed new velodrome can only be delivered if the Maindy track closes, as it absolutely relies on a funding contribution from the education capital programme.* as without the contribution from the Cardiff's Education budget the scheme cannot be delivered due to limitations on the Economic Development Department's capital budget.
- Cardiff Council operates its own Education Capital Programme with a wider scope than 21st Century Schools as it incorporates for example an Asset Renewal strand and also adds to the capital funds provided by WG for ICT investment to enable scaling up of investment in education across the city.
- Its own capital funds are sourced from the wider capital budget of the authority or by revenue that facilitates borrowing.
- As required by the grant terms and conditions Cardiff acknowledge WG's contribution when deployed in thier Education Capital Programme.
