Thank you for your request which I received on 8 November 2022. You asked for:

A copy of the school allocations for the Pupil Development Grant (PDG) and Early Years Pupil Development Grant (EYPDG) individual allocations for the year 2019 to 2020.

Our response

The information you requested is enclosed. Please note that the allocations in 2018/19 and 2019/20 were both based on Pupil Level Annual School Census (PLASC) data from 2016. This was because the PLASC data from 2017 showed a drop in the overall percentage of learners eligible for Free School Meals (eFSM). It was therefore of benefit to the education system to use PLASC data from 2016 instead of the latest data available.

It was also decided by the then Cabinet Secretary for Education to provide assurance that the PDG would remain for the duration of the Assembly term by guaranteeing allocation levels for 2018-19 and 2019-20, enabling schools to continue to make sustainable, long-term decisions on investment that help identify and address barriers to learning.
